

Indocement Commemorates National Waste Awareness Day 2023

PT Indocement Tunggal Prakarsa Tbk. (Indocement) commemorated National Waste Awareness Day on February 21, 2023, through a variety of activities at its three factory complexes:

Citeureup Factory

Indocement's Citeureup Factory organized a Waste Donation activity for Indocement employees at Harmony Corner. Participation in the activity held for National Waste Awareness Day 2023 was recorded as one hour of employee volunteering. The initiative aimed to encourage employees to sort household waste—including plastic, paper, cardboard, textiles, rubber, and used cooking oil—at home. For every 3 kg of waste submitted, employees received one point. The points could be accumulated and redeemed for souvenirs, while also giving participants the opportunity to win a grand prize at the end of the year. Indocement will use the collected waste as alternative fuel. A total of 925.5 kg of waste was collected.

Cirebon Factory

Indocement's Cirebon Factory, in collaboration with the Cirebon Regency Environmental Agency, held waste management training based on the reduce, reuse, and recycle (3R) approach and signed a commitment to support the development of Adiwiyata Schools in Cirebon Regency. The event was held at the P4M Building, Cirebon Factory, on February 23, 2023.

Tarjun Factory

Indocement's Tarjun Factory organized a clean-up program along the mangrove coastline near the Tarjun jetty, as well as a waste-for-exclusive-souvenirs exchange program for employees and their families. Participants in the waste exchange program were asked to bring at least 10 kg of household waste in the form of tires, paper, cardboard, and plastic in exchange for souvenirs. The event, held on February 21, 2023, at the Main Gate Roundabout of the Tarjun Factory, collected 1,294 kg of waste.

In addition, on February 17, 2023, Indocement employees, residents of partner villages, and government officials carried out a waste clean-up drive in Tarjun Village and Langadai Village. The activity involved 150 participants.

Indocement Director and Corporate Secretary Antonius Marcos stated that these activities were part of Indocement's efforts to encourage better household waste management in Indonesia. Previously, Indocement had signed a cooperation agreement with the Provincial Government of Jakarta for the supply of refuse-derived fuel (RDF) produced by the Bantargebang Integrated Waste Treatment Facility (TPST). Indocement had also signed a memorandum of understanding with the Tanah Bumbu Regency Government for the supply of alternative fuel derived from household waste processing.

Indocement is one of Indonesia's largest cement producers, manufacturing Semen Tiga Roda and Semen Rajawali. Indocement and its subsidiaries currently operate in several business fields,

including the manufacture and sale of cement as their core business, ready-mixed concrete, and the mining of aggregates and trass, with approximately 4,700 employees. Indocement operates 13 plants with a total annual production capacity of 25.5 million tons of cement. Heidelberg Materials has been Indocement's majority shareholder since 2001.
