

Indocement Strengthens the Competencies of Indonesia's Construction Workforce through Training and Certification

PT Indocement Tunggal Prakarsa Tbk. (Indocement) continues to support competency development for Indonesia's construction workforce through training and certification programs. Following its successful facilitation of certification for 300 construction workers in 2025, Indocement facilitated training and certification for another 205 construction workers across several regions in the first half of 2026.

The program forms part of Indocement's commitment to strengthening the quality of human resources in the construction sector while encouraging the implementation of standardized work practices in the field. It also reflects Indocement's collaboration with various stakeholders in supporting higher-quality and more sustainable development.

In the first half of 2026, the training and certification series included 23 Building Construction Head Craftsmen, in collaboration with the Jakarta Provincial Human Settlements Agency, on May 19-20, 2026, in Jakarta; 23 Building Construction Supervisors, in collaboration with the Sumedang Regency Public Works Agency and the management board of an Islamic boarding school, on May 19, 2026, in Sumedang, West Java; and 21 Building Construction Foremen, in collaboration with the Jakarta Provincial Human Settlements Agency and Lifetime Design, a contractor, on July 27-28, 2026, in Jakarta.

Indocement also facilitated training and certification for 41 Concrete Laboratory Technicians, in collaboration with the Banjar City Public Works Agency, on July 29, 2026, in Banjar City, West Java; and 97 Bricklayers, in collaboration with the Regional Construction Services Center III Jakarta and Commission V of the House of Representatives of the Republic of Indonesia, on July 29-30, 2026, in Purwakarta, West Java.

"For Indocement, supporting the certification of construction workers is not merely a marketing activity, but part of our efforts to build an increasingly competent, productive, and standards-driven construction ecosystem. Through Semen Tiga Roda, we aim to ensure that construction workers have access to technical knowledge, proper application practices, and an understanding of quality materials, so that construction projects in Indonesia can become stronger, safer, and more sustainable," said Indocement Director Troy Dartojo Sopotro.

The training and certification sessions were conducted by instructors from Semen Tiga Roda's Technical Engineer team, who hold instructor certification from the National Professional Certification Agency (BNSP). The training materials covered an introduction to quality materials, including cement, mortar, and concrete; product application; the handling of technical issues in the field; and practical tips to support the quality of construction work. As a cement brand produced by Indocement, Semen Tiga Roda is developed with a focus on quality and innovation to meet domestic and international construction needs. Indocement's cement products include Portland Composite Cement (PCC), Type I, II, and V Portland Cement, Oil Well Cement, White Cement, and Mortar Tiga Roda.
