

# Commemorating *Hari Bangunan Indonesia* 2023, Indocement Holds Futsal Tournament

- The theme of Hari Bangunan Indonesia (HBI) 2023 is "Raising Togetherness and Collaboration of Indonesian Construction People for a Better Future of Indonesia"

Jakarta, 11 November 2023 - PT Indocement Tunggal Prakarsa Tbk. (Indocement) holds futsal tournament for construction people in Indonesia at Galaxy Sport Center, PIK 2, Jakarta. This tournament was participated by 16 teams from ministries, ready-mix concrete, contactors, developers, alumni of Sekolah Tukang Tiga Roda program, and others. The opening was attended by the Director General of Construction Development of the Ministry of PUPR, Rachman Arief Dienaputra and the Director of Indocement, Troy D. Soputro, as well as several companies' chairman that took part in this competition.

"On 1-3 of November, the PUPR Ministry held an Indonesian Construction event, where Indocement was also part of the event, various new knowledge was shared in various seminar series, educating each other through exhibition booths and also competitions for Indonesian construction workers. The event was attended by representatives from various provinces in Indonesia. "To complement and strengthen the togetherness of Indonesian construction people while commemorating HBI on November 11, we took the initiative to hold a more fun activity in the form of a futsal tournament," said Troy D. Soputro.

The winner of this futsal tournament will receive a cash prize and the PUPR Ministry's HBI Cup. This trophy is made from Semen Tiga Roda combined with used cement sack waste, which is a symbol of the importance of sustainability for all Indonesian construction workers.

Director General of Construction Development, Rachman Arief Dienaputra, officially opened this futsal tournament. Rachman Arief said that holding HBI 2023 Futsal tournament could create closeness, unity and integrity among construction actors to face future challenges so that the construction services industry would progress further and provide benefits for many parties. He wished that this futsal competition will become an opportunity to increase togetherness between the government, business players and the construction services industry, and the construction services community.

The winner of this tournament was the team from the Ministry of PUPR who managed to beat PT PPLI in a fierce final match. This cup will be contested again at HBI next year.
